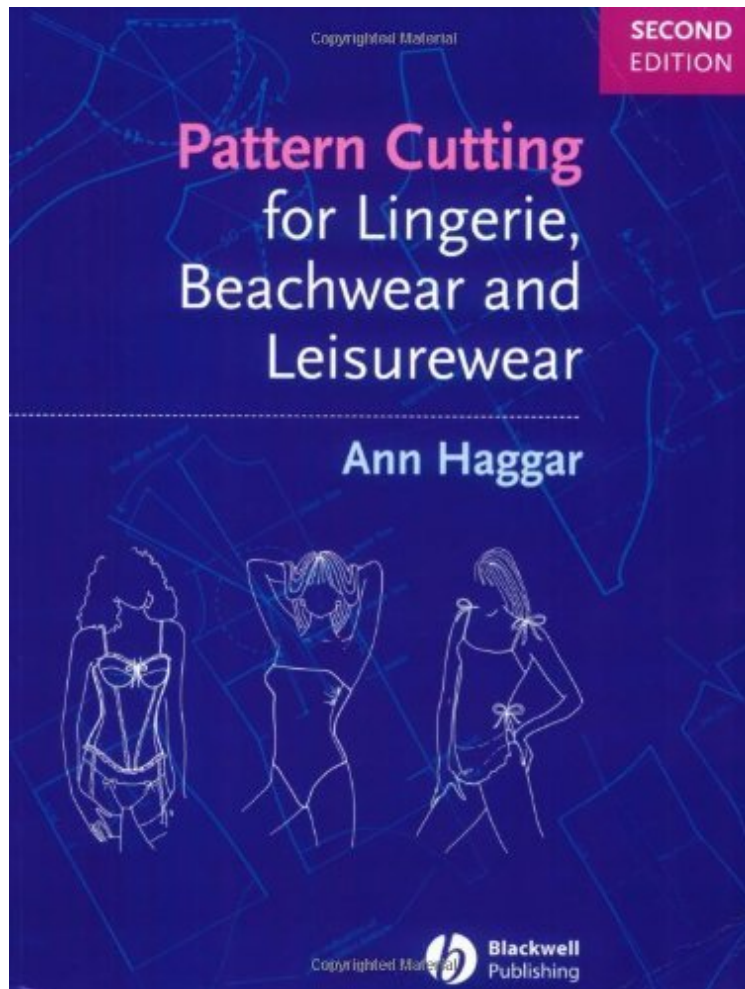

Some initiative is required for a deeper understanding, if that's what you are after.Other than that I found the instructions for basics easy to follow (especially with a computer-aided drafting program, rather than by hand. TONS of time saved!!!). Considers the influence of choice of fabric on the way a pattern works.
