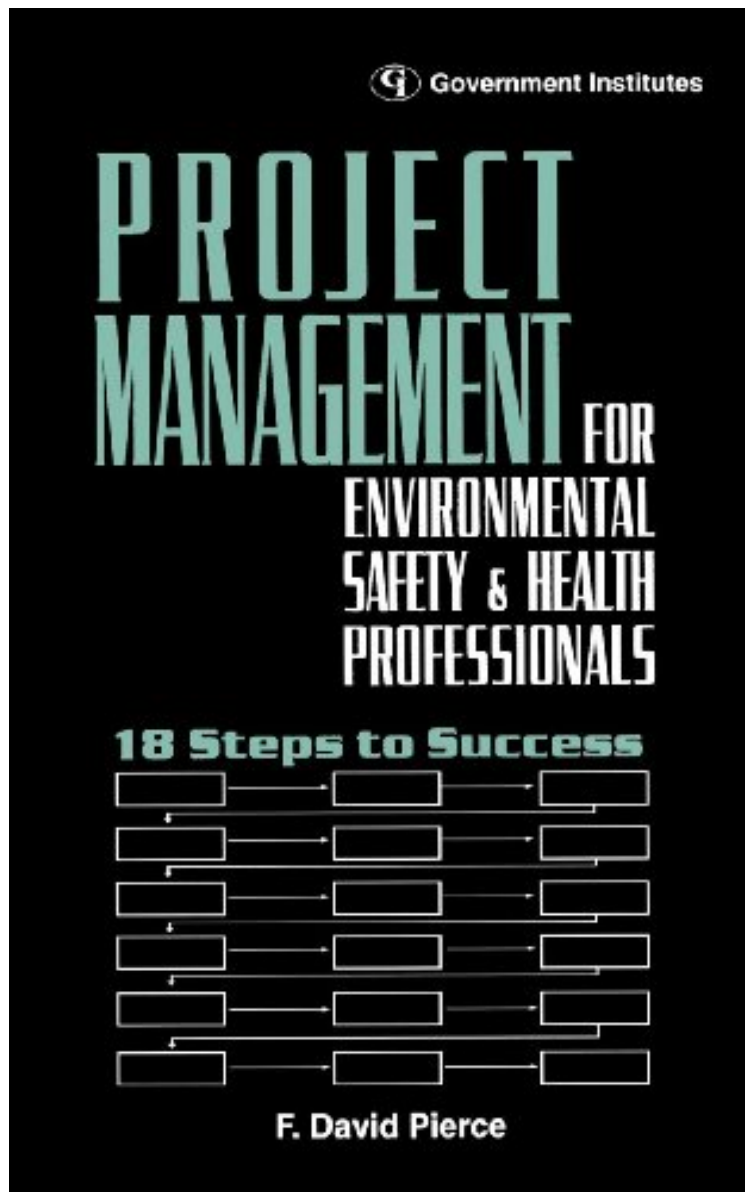

Pierce's book is much more readable, with useful anecdotes and applied discussions, but it is also very out-dated. The entire chapter on tools debates the merits of paper versus computerized tracking as they were in the 1990s.It's not very heavy on the topic of environment, safety, and health, most of the discussions are generic. It's vastly superior to the PMI text, but that's not saying very much.
